Virtual Talk: **Audrey Tang** | Digital Minister of Taiwan | Taiwan

Harnessing Technology to Solve Global Challenges

The Minister underlined the importance of declaring as a basic human right (right up there with healthcare!) the access to universal broadband. The implementation in Taiwan provides for citizens to have a "digital public infrastructure". All people of all ages should be able - and encouraged - to contribute to fact-finding, what Audrey calls the "democratisation of journalism".

Another starting point for Audrey is shifting perspectives. If the focus shifts from 'software engineering' to a more inclusive, diversity-focused area of study and work that emphasises connecting people to people, then many more people will get involved in development in this area.



Takeaways

- Encourage everyone to have a voice, develop it and use it.
- Trust. Essential to business and any functioning society, it takes years to build up but just moments to destroy.
- Education. Use new approaches, and never stop learning. Without it, our innate human creativity simply goes to waste.

The realisation that she cannot be everything to everyone, but must concentrate on her core competencies, was the key to success for Helga. Immediately after setting up her company, she hired an interim manager to take over the day-to-day administrative tasks while she concentrated on the scientific projects and finding new approaches. This was not only a very wise decision, but also in line with her conviction that you have to decide what to focus on and what to delegate.

- Be clear about what you want. With passion and conviction, you will succeed.
- Learn to find your power. If you want to change things, you're going to need it!
- Be flexible. Leadership is a balance between chaos and vision!
- Stay curious. "What's next?" is a great question!
